It has been shown that having family nearby is a vital component in speeding the recovery of a patient. That's what Fisher House Boston will make possible.


But we need your help to make this facility a reality... Our goal is to raise \$2 Million, which is half the amount necessary to build a Fisher House.

It's only been two years since Sgt. James Lathan found himself as an inpatient at the VA hospital in West Roxbury. He underwent advanced procedures and endured grueling rehabilitation. All the while, his family was close at hand.

Unfortunately, his wife and young son also endured hardship. They had one small hotel room in which to live. No playroom, no laundry and each meal had to be purchased at a restaurant. All this could have been avoided with a local Fisher House.

As planned, the Fisher House, Boston will offer 21 suites where patients' families can live—offering all the comforts of home for free, as long as necessary during veteran's treatment.

Fisher Houses make keeping families together a reality. It is a support network, it's a place to stay. But most important, it's about the families of our heroes.

Serious injuries and illnesses don't recognize rank, race, gender, or economic status. Their emotional, financial, and physical stress can be devastating - both for those who are ill or wounded and for their families. Fortunately for anny current or former member of the armed forces, the resources of the Fisher House, Boston program are nearby.

A long-term stay at a military hospital often means expensive lodging and long separations from loved ones. Fisher House facilities change all this.

Fisher Houses are home-away-from-home residences specifically designed to house and support the families of our veterans.

Fisher House by the numbers: Homes between 5,000 and 16,000 square feet. Designed with up to 21 guest suites. Fully furnished with in-room telephones, cable TV/VCRs, laundry and computers with Internet access.

Each House also has a well-stocked community kitchen, spacious dining areas, and living rooms with libraries and toys for children. But it's more than that Fisher Houses become a support network within the house, it's not just a place to sleep. It's getting together & supporting each other through bad days and sharing the joy on good days. That is the beauty of the Fisher House.

And there is always a caring staff to assist Fisher House guests during their stay.
